



# Invaders and Settlers - Year 4/5



## NC objectives:

History: the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain; Britain's settlement by Anglo-Saxons and Scots; the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England to the time of Edward the Confessor

Geography: use maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate countries; use the eight points of a compass, four and six-figure grid references, symbols and key (including the use of Ordnance Survey maps) to build their knowledge of the United Kingdom and the wider world

## Pupils will be asked:

- ✓ Who were the Romans and where did they come from?
- ✓ What is Binchester Roman Fort?
- ✓ Who was Boudica?
- ✓ What was life like in Roman Britain?
- ✓ Why did the Romans leave Britain and who replaced them?
- ✓ When and where did the Vikings attack Britain?
- ✓ What was Danelaw?
- ✓ Who was Alfred the Great?
- ✓ What was life like for Vikings in Britain?
- ✓ How did the Anglo Saxon and Viking era end?

## Curriculum Aspirations

Public transport trip to both York and Binchester Roman Fort. Artefacts and Non fiction books from DLR

Look at the impact of Romans on modern life. Visit local sites of interest. Discuss current day/recent invasions and wars.

Tasks set throughout this unit will encourage development in concentration, resilience, imagination, co-operation and the enjoyment of learning.
