**TV show:** Cooking programmes

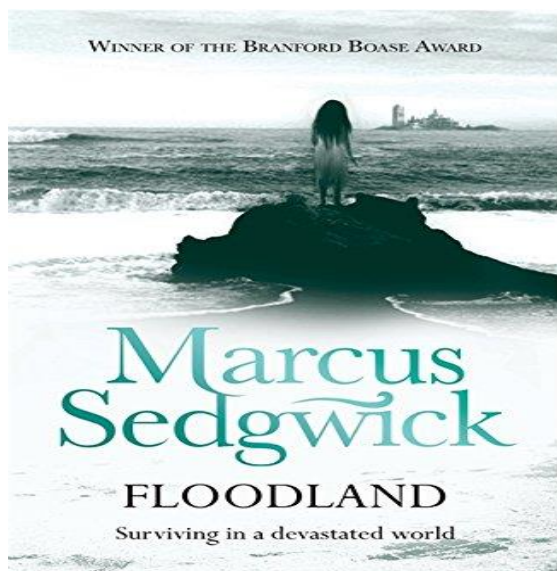
**Movie:** Home Alone
